Instrument Loan

1



Please do not travel to High House Production Park to pick up an instrument if you are feeling unwell or any members of your family are showing signs of Coronavirus.

2



Please wait to be contacted by TMS admin to tell you the instrument is ready and to arrange a pick up time. Do not just turn up unannounced.

3



Instruments are to be collected from the Granary at High House Production Park, please use the hand sanitiser on entering the room.

4



Please bring your own pen to sign the documentation.

5



Only one person from the household should come to pick up the instrument. 6



Please wear a facemask when on site at High House Production Park.

Please wipe down the instrument case and in particular the handle with an antibacterial wet-wipe before returning the instrument

Please wear a facemask and disposable gloves when returning the instrument. 5



Only one person from the household should come to return the instrument. 6
